ARE YOU READY FOR CHRISTMAS?

The store displays and advertisements have been urging us to get ready for months. I still can't get used to seeing Christmas merchandise on shelves in September. But now that Thanksgiving is over and it's December...we can, in earnest, start thinking about getting ready for Christmas. There's cards to send, gifts to buy, decorations to put up, gatherings to plan, meals to prepare.



Jesus talks about <u>being ready</u>. But in a much different way and for a much different occasion. In the Advent season, we often think about His first advent, his coming to Bethlehem in the manger. But Jesus talks about his second advent, his coming in glory at the end of time.

And this is more than getting ready with cards and parties and shopping and decorations. Getting ready for the last day is to look to the <u>first</u> coming of Christ and to see that as a reminder <u>that</u> he comes to us today in Word and Sacraments and to trust that <u>this</u> prepares us for His coming at the end of the age.

Jesus' disciples ask him about the end of age. And Jesus calls them and us, his church, to live in constant readiness...because his coming will be at an hour when we do not expect him. Jesus says: "Be vigilant. Be ready."

Now, if you ask people if they're <u>ready for Christmas</u>, you'll get a lot of different answers. But what if someone asked you about meeting the Lord when he returns? "Jesus is coming back...What if that's today? Are you ready?" Do your daily activities and decisions and priorities show that you are ready? We're tempted to think..."Come on, What's the big rush? Jesus said he would come back to take us to be with him, but that was 2000 years ago, and he hasn't come yet. So what's the hurry? We've got plenty of time, right?"

Well, Let's not be so sure of that. We love to procrastinate, don't we? We put things off until its convenient or it's absolutely necessary to give it our attention. Well, it's one thing to procrastinate on paying a bill or making a doctor's appointment. It's quite another to procrastinate when it comes to God. You and I today, are called to constant vigilance. Jesus says to us: "The time to be ready is now. Keep watch." There is no time to put off our preparation.

But how do you prepare for the unexpected? How do you get ready for something you can't predict? Well, first and foremost, we prepare by listening to the words of Jesus. We don't look to the future with fear, because we know that each day is a new day for us to listen to Jesus. When John the Baptist prepared people for the first advent of Christ he said, "Repent, be baptized, turn from your sin. Behold the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world. Trust him and his saving work"

That's also the best preparation for us. The best way to prepare for Christmas and for Christ's second coming...To believe that Jesus came to live and die for us. And that in him we are safe and secure. Jesus is your gracious Lord and Savior. And He is the one who is coming for you. It was your gracious Lord and Savior who was born as a baby in Bethlehem for you. It was your gracious Lord and savior who took on human flesh to pay the penalty for your sin.

In Jesus, God has fulfilled his promise to send a savior. And you and I share in the deliverance brought to us by the birth of the Christ-Child so many years ago. You are the reason Christmas happened in the first place. Christmas is for you and for your salvation. Consider this Advent season how blessed we are. Blessed beyond imagination. Blessed with forgiveness of sin, blessed with victory over satan, blessed with hope of eternal life. Hold on to these blessings won by Jesus upon the cross.

The best way to prepare for Christmas and for Christ's second coming is believing that Jesus came to live and die for you.

As we enter into the season of Advent, we wait in eager, joyful expectation for the celebration of Christ's nativity. His coming as a child to the manger. But this celebration is also a reminder that Jesus will also come again someday. The call goes out: "Watch. Be ready." This is a call to put out lives, our hope, our faith into God's hands. Because our Lord who will return someday is also our gracious Lord and Savior. In him we are made ready by his shed blood and his triumphant resurrection. Because of this we may confidently pray: "Come quickly Lord Jesus."

AUNT TERRY'S TALLERINO ~ (THIS IS WHAT SHE CALLED IT) PREP. TIME: 5 MINUTES COOK TIME: 35 MINUTES SERVINGS: 5

INGREDIENTS:

BUTTER-FLAVORED COOKING SPRAY 1 (12 OZ.) PKG. EGG NOODLES*

1 LB. LEAN GROUND BEEF 1 PINCH SEASONING SALT 1 PINCH BLACK PEPPER 1 PINCH GARLIC POWDER

1 (11 OZ.) CAN CANNED WHOLE-KERNEL CORN WITH RED AND GREEN BELL PEPPERS

1 (10 OZ.) CAN DICED TOMATOES WITH GREEN CHILE PEPPERS ½ LB. PROCESSED CHEESE FOOD (SUCH AS VELVEETA), SLICED

1 CAN OF OLIVES SLICED (BLACK OR GREEN WITH PIMENTO ~YOUR CHOICE)

DIRECTIONS:

01) PREHEAT THE OVEN TO 375 DEGREES F (190 DEGREES C).

02) SPRAY A CASSEROLE DISH WITH BUTTER-FLAVORED COOKING SPRAY.

03) FILL A LARGE POT WITH LIGHTLY SALTED WATER AND BRING TO A RAPID BOIL.

04) COOK EGG NOODLES AT A BOIL UNTIL AL DENTE, 7 TO 9 MINS. DRAIN WELL.

- 05) MEANWHILE, COOK GROUND BEEF IN A LARGE SKILLET WITH SEASONING SALT, BLACK PEPPER, AND GARLIC POWDER UNTIL BROWNED. ADD CORN AND DICED TOMATOES WITH GREEN CHILES AND THE OLIVES AND MIX WELL. POUR MIXTURE INTO THE PREPARED CASSEROLE DISH, ARRANGE CHEESE SLICES OVER TOP, AND COVER WITH ALUMINUM FOIL*.
- 06) Bake in the preheated oven for 20 to 30 minutes. Stir before serving.

*(MY AUNT USED SHREDDED CHEDDAR CHEESE AND SHE JUST POURED THE MIXTURE)
(OVER THE NOODLES AND SERVED IT)*



*IF YOU DO NOT LIKE SPICY FOODS - PLEASE NOTE, MY
