HAPPY 492ND BIRTHDAY, AUGSBURG CONFESSION!

We've been looking at the Augsburg Confession this in our Midweek study. It was prepared by Phillip Melanchthon (Martin Luther's right hand man) and presented to the Emperor in June 25, 1530 (492 years ago!) as a summary of what Lutherans believe.

In this document, over and over again the Reformers display great concern for those with anxious, terrified consciences and show a great desire for the Gospel of free forgiveness though Christ to

provide consolation.

The church of Rome had obscured and smothered the gospel of Jesus by insisting and demanding that people follow Rome's traditions (even above the commands of God) to earn God's grace. But this added even more burden, because neither Rome's traditions nor God's commands can be followed perfectly.

There is still great need in our day for consolation to come to those with anxious, terrified consciences. There is so much that causes worry and fear in our world. Uncertainly reigns.

Many claim to be in the right and demand: "Say this," "Do this," "Think like this." But there is no end. It is never enough. And for all the assertions about what the "right thing" is, we see that what is true today can be taboo tomorrow.

Consolation comes not from what WE think, what WE say, or what WE do, but from what has been done for us. Christ died to put and end to the law's demands. The world says "Do this." Christ says: "It is already done. It is finished."

That is what brings true comfort and peace. So in Christ, we can go into our vocations as the forgiven children of God and show love to others, not as a demand or obligation, but in response to the love we have been shown.

The comforting gospel message of God's grace through faith for Christ's sake never grows old. This is what the Reformers confessed 492 years old. It's what we confess and cherish in 2022. And, it's what the church will confess 492 years from now, if the Lord has not returned by then. I can't guarantee that there will still be a structure standing at 1460 Hilby Ave in the year 2514, but I can guarantee that as long as there is an earth, there will be the comfort of sins forgiven in Christ. **THANKS BE TO GOD**.

SALSA VERDE CHICKEN CASSEROLE

TOTAL TIME: Prep/Total Time: 30 min. YIELD: 6 servings.

INGREDIENTS:

2 CUPS SHREDDED ROTISSERIE CHICKEN

1 CUP SOUR CREAM

1-1/2 CUPS SALSA VERDE, DIVIDED

8 CORN TORTILLAS (6 INCHES)

2 CUPS CHOPPED TOMATOES

1/4 CUP MINCED FRESH CILANTRO

2 CUPS SHREDDED MONTEREY JACK CHEESE



OPTIONAL TOPPINGS: AVOCADO SLICES, THINLY SLICED GREEN ONIONS OR FRESH CILANTRO

DIRECTIONS:

- 1. In a small bowl, combine the chicken, sour cream and 3/4 cup
- **2.** SALSA. SPREAD 1/4 CUP SALSA ON THE BOTTOM OF A GREASED 8-IN. SQUARE BAKING DISH.
- 3. LAYER WITH HALF OF THE TORTILLAS AND CHICKEN MIXTURE; SPRINKLE WITH HALF THE TOMATOES, MINCED CILANTRO AND HALF OF THE CHEESE. REPEAT LAYERS WITH REMAINING TORTILLAS, CHICKEN MIXTURE, TOMATOES AND CHEESE.
- **4.** Bake, uncovered, at 400° until bubbly, 20-25 minutes. Serve with remaining salsa and, if desired, optional toppings.
