<u>GOD AT WORK IN YOU</u>

During the Easter Season, we heard the story of Stephen the first Christian martyr (Acts 6-7). He was the first in a line of saints who have made a bold confession of Christ in the face of a hostile world. Saints who "mocked the cross and flame, met the tyrant's brandished steel, the lion's gory mane"...as it says in the hymn "The Son of God Goes Forth to War".

But if I'm honest, the martyrdom of Stephen can feel quite removed from my everyday life.

Waking up, making breakfast, brushing my teeth, sending emails.

Compared to the stories of martyrs and the Acts of the Apostles. I feel like I don't really make the cut.

My life is mundane and ordinary. What do I have in common with them? Ever feel that way?

But the truth is, Jesus is still there. He is there in the mundane.

If you take a look earlier in our reading from Acts. Things don't seem all that spectacular for Stephen. No, they look quite mundane and ordinary. The disciples needed people to wait tables. To work in the divine food service industry distributing food to widows in need.

Stephen was not all that far removed from a pizza delivery guy or Amazon driver. "Steve, Take this food and make sure it gets to Mrs Schmidtke."

Mundane. Ordinary. But you know what? God was there. Stephen, in his serving, was full of faith and the Holy Spirit. Even in the midst of his daily tasks.

It's the same with you and I. God uses you to wait tables. Maybe its your kids or your spouse or your parents or your friends and neighbors or church members. We all have ordinary tasks, mundane vocations that God has given us. But he is present as we serve others. He uses us as his hands and his feet to provide his daily bread to others in this world.

We don't need to be thrown to the lions or tied to a burning stake to give witness to Christ. We do it daily in word and deed where God has placed us. Even as Stephen was waiting tables he was full of faith and the Spirit. Full of grace and power. In his serving...and in his speaking.

Now, we can understand the waiting tables and serving others part. But what about the speaking? What about the bold witness?

Personally, I look at Stephen's bold confession and then and then I look at myself...and I can see a much different story. Often I'm silent when I ought to speak. Afraid. Worried that I'll say the wrong thing, or cause offense, or start an argument.

It's hard. Because so many people don't understand. They don't know Jesus or they have strayed from him. And we can feel like fish out of water sometimes even with friends and family. When given an opportunity, we often fail to bear witness and can get discouraged.

What do we have in common with Stephen?

Well, Stephen was full of grace and power because he was filled with faith and the Holy Spirit.

You and I are filled with the same Holy spirit. It happened in our baptism - a gift of God given through his word and promise. And with that comes power and grace... boldness and confidence.

The word of God implanted in our hearts and our lives is always active. Always effective. As we are sent to speak the truth in love and sow seeds of forgiveness.

We may not see the effects...but where the gospel goes out, the promise is there. And by the power of the spirit, according to his manner and his timing, the seed will sprout to faith.

The same spirt and the same Jesus that was with Stephen is with you. God is with you and is at work in every part of your life. He is present in your serving and in your speaking.

In the name of Jesus. Amen.

MEATBALLS 3 WAYS


DIRECTIONS:

TAKE OUT 5 OR 6 MEATBALLS PER PERSON (LESS/MORE IF YOU WANT) AND PREPARE AS THE PACKAGE SUGGESTS. WHEN THE MEATBALLS ARE COOKED, POUR IN THE SAUCE OF YOUR CHOICE. HEAT UNTIL THE SAUCE IS WARMED UP.

EXAMPLES:

WITH THE TERIYAKI SAUCE - SERVE OVER RICE OR VEGETABLES. WITH THE MARINERA SAUCE - SERVE OVER NOODLES. WITH THE MARINERA SAUCE - SERVE INSIDE A HOAGIE ROLL WITH GRILLED VEGGIES. WITH THE BBQ SAUCE - SERVE OVER MASHED POTATOES. WITH THE BBQ SAUCE - SERVE INSIDE A HOAGIE ROLL.
